## **Living by Water Shoreline Advisor**

Nature Alberta has the opportunity to hire two (2) Shoreline Advisors to assist with the Living by Water (LBW) program delivery through the summer of 2017.

### **Position Description**

Reporting to the LBW Program Coordinator and Executive Director, and working closely with other Nature Alberta staff, the Shoreline Advisors will be responsible for assisting with the implementation of the LBW program. Positions are based out of Edmonton, with significant travel required throughout Alberta.

### **Roles and Responsibilities**

- Participate in shoreline consultation and assessment training;
- Work closely with community volunteers to secure property consultations;
- Independently conduct property consultations and shoreline assessments on lake properties throughout Alberta;
- Write high quality reports for property consultation participants;
- Develop and deliver presentations to community audiences;
- Attend events to increase awareness and uptake of the LBW program;
- Assist with shoreline naturalization projects.

### **Qualifications**

- Enrolled in a post-secondary institution working toward a degree or diploma in environmental studies, natural sciences, or a similar discipline. Must be returning to school in the fall.
- Knowledge of riparian and water related topics.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Detail-oriented with excellent organizational skills.
- Strong verbal and written communication.
- Computer proficiency, including use of Microsoft office.
- Must possess a valid Class 5 Alberta Driver's License and clean abstract.
- Reliable transportation and insurance is necessary.
- Plant identification skills are an asset.

**Hours of Work:** 35 hours per week, May to August, 2017. Ability to work holidays, evenings and weekends is required.
